A message from our NCRC President: Norm O'Brien

Welcome to my September note from North County Republican Club. School has started and we're heading into fall. With that, we will begin our monthly meetings. I've been looking forward to our meeting on September 21 where we will hold a debate on the Convention of States. See below for more information.

We also had a very successful picnic this year with 70 attendees including people from The AA County Republican Central Committee, District 32 Republican Club, Republican Women of Anne Arundel County, Severna Park Republican Women's Club, and the newly formed Crofton, Odenton, Gambrills, and Surrounding Area Club (COGS). Also present were Delegate Nic Kipke, Councilman Shannon Leadbetter, Former Sheriff Jim Fredericks, current Board of Education member, Corine Frank, Board of Education candidate LaToya Nkongolo, and Board of Election member, Bob Atkins. Also stopping in were State Senator Bryan Simonaire and Delegate Stu Schmidt.

Last year a bill was introduced into the Maryland house (HJ0002) and senate (SJ0001) to propose amendments to the U.S. Constitution that impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and limit the terms of office for officials of the federal government and for the members of the U.S. Congress. This was submitted in accordance with Article V of the US Constitution. The bill languished in committee. This debate should give us enough information to understand both sides of this issue to determine whether we fight to have the bill passed or as they say in New Jersey, fogetaboutit.

Mark Fisher, who introduced the bill in the house will speak in the affirmative for the Convention of the States.

Pastor David Whitney, who teaches courses on both the US Constitution and the Maryland Constitution will speak in the negative of the Convention of the States.

The debate will follow the Lincoln-Douglas debate style of the National Speech and Debate Association. Only one speaker will speak at a time and there will be no interruptions. Councilman Nathan Volke has agreed to be the moderator.

Our meetings are on the third Thursday of the month at 7:00 PM in the meeting hall in the Lake Shore Volunteer Fire Department at 4498 Mountain Road, Pasadena, Maryland 21122. We hope to see you there.




