The Maryland General Assembly Delegate from District 31, Rachel Munoz, has submitted her letter of resignation and her replacement will be selected by the Anne Arundel County Republican Central Committee. Besides being of voting age and being a republican, the replacement must have lived in District 31 for six months prior to their application. The call is out for residents of District 31 to apply.

The application must be received by the Central Committee by December 23, 2024, so time is of the essence. I will also inform the other republican clubs that you will apply and are looking for their endorsement which would be very helpful.

The newsletter is out with time to register for our Christmas dinner/auction. It will be on December 12th at 6:30pm and be held at Mike's Inland Sunset Inn at 625 Greenway Road SE in Glen Burnie. The charity we will be sponsoring this year is the "**Marines Helping Heroes Foundation**", a 501(c) 3 organization which directly benefits our local active-duty military, veterans of all branches of the military, first responders, and other 'hero' communities. Representatives from the charity will be available to discuss their mission and answer questions. The club is charging a \$5.00 entrance fee to cover the cost of dinners for the marines attending that represent the charity and to be able to ensure enough seating will be available since seating is limited to 40. You will be able to order from the menu for your meal. If you are not familiar with the auction, everyone attending brings an <u>unmarked wrapped present</u>. The presents are all placed on a table and auctioned off one at a time. In past years we were able to raise as much as \$2,000 for our sponsored charities. Our January meeting will go into depth on the results of our November election. Nathan Volke, our District 3 councilman, will go into the election statistics, what they mean, and outline what the club can do the next time to improve the results. He will be teamed with our own board member, Dave Morsberger, who will talk about the good points and bad points from the candidate's perspective of the November election. He plans to use that to come up with a plan for better results in the next election and has been working to develop an action plan and will brief us on the progress. If we don't improve, we won't get better results. Nathan will also be swearing in our new Officers and Board of Directors as they begin their 2-year term of office.

I'm looking forward to our February meeting. Brian Chrisholm, our very own District 31 Delegate to the Maryland General Assembly (MGA) will go over the coming electricity tsunami for our county. Due to the irresponsibility of the MGA, they instituted impossible requirements for 2 AA county power plants and now they are closing. Now we will be left with a power deficit with the associated increased cost of our electricity. My own contract expired in November and the best contract I could find was with a 33% increase in price. He will outline what is being done and the impact of it on our community.

It is with great regret that I must tell you of Chris Ronk's passing. As most of you know, Chris has been suffering for the last several months with recurring cancer and its complications. She has been a friend, a co-worker, and our Recording Secretary. Despite her illness, she remained very active in both the Severna Park Republican Women's Club and ours, and never complained. She was even out on election day, despite the pain she was in, encouraging voters in republican causes. I can't think of an event where she was not there with grace and her ever-present smile. She will be truly missed.
